THE BIG NEWS....we have been granted a **National Let Them Be Kids Helping Hands Award!!** What began as a long term fund raising project for the school and its parent council has been transformed into a 6 month project! The award provides a 50/50 matching grant towards the purchase of playground equipment, as well as support, training and resources to help make this community project successful. Every 50¢ we raise, will result in \$1 in buying power! We are half-way there!!!!

THE NEED....The wooden play structure on the joint-use playground, adjacent to Elizabeth Rummel School, has been slated for removal by May 2010, due to wear and tear leading to potential safety issues. There is no immediate funding available through the province or the town.

THE ACTIVITY....Volunteers will come together to raise a playground structure in one day! We will rejuvenate the grounds, the outdoor classroom, nature trail, field area, and more!

THE IMPACT....The goal is not only to enhance the lives of children by providing a safe and stimulating play area, but also to create a social hub where all residents can connect, to foster pride and ownership within the community by working towards a common goal and legacy, to model active volunteerism, leadership and democracy to our children, and to actively engage newcomers and part-time residents in the project. The desired outcome is a more tolerant, united, welcoming community, empowered to create positive change with an increased capacity and more enriched fabric.
